Yokoteen's works celebrate **the beauty and serenity found in the natural world** while also **exploring the philosophical symbolism of water and the color blue**. **Blue Breeze series portrays moments of serenity and tranquility**, captured through the artist's extraordinary use of **bright colours and fluid brushstrokes**, conveying **the theme of rebirth and purity through the use of blue and water with a sense of flow and movement that adds to the overall feeling of calmness**.

The fluidity and transparency of water suggest a sense of purity and cleansing, inviting viewers to reflect on their spiritual experiences and the interconnectedness of all things.

Through the use of color, brushstrokes, and subject matter, Yokoteen's art invites viewers to step into a world of calm and reflection. The serene moments captured in **the paintings encourage the viewer to take a moment to appreciate the beauty of the world and consider the deeper meanings that lie beneath the surface**.

**The themes of water's wisdom and memory** evoked by Yokoteen's artwork take the viewer on a journey through the world of this extraordinary Japanese painter who meticulously explores the symbolism of water in all its forms with a joyful aquamarine palette that reflects the artist's technical skill and attention to detail. **This exhibition is a celebration of the wisdom and beauty of water and the profound lessons it can teach about life**.
